



Mariam Battistelli

International award winning Italian soprano **Mariam Battistelli** was born in Ethiopia. She is currently soprano of the Vienna State Opera. Her performing breakthrough came when she performed as Il Paggio under the baton of *Zubin Mehta* in a production by *Marco Bellocchio* of *Rigoletto in Madova*, alongside *Plácido Domingo* and *Ruggero Raimondi*.

During her studies at the *Centre Perfeccionament Plácido Domingo (Palau de les Arts' Opera Studio)* in Valencia she made her debut in numerous different roles. Highlights included *Il Musico in Manon Lescaut / Puccini*, *Statira in L'Incoronazione di Dario / Vivaldi* and *Juditha in Juditha Triumphans / Vivaldi* (conducted by *Federico Maria Sardelli* and directed by *Davide Livermore*).

Following Mariam's success with *Il Musico in Manon Lescaut* she was invited to record this role alongside tenor *Andrea Bocelli* (with *Plácido Domingo* conducting), whilst she appeared in the prestigious *Belcanto* concert performing under the direction of *Gregory Kunde*. Mariam additionally gave the world premiere at the Royal Opera House Muscat of "The Opera!", singing *Euridice (Steven Mercurio / Davide Livermore)*.

A major prizewinner at the *International Maria Callas Verona Competition* and the *International Competition Franca Mattiucci*, Mariam Battistelli was the 1st prize winner of the *International Singing Competition Ottavio Ziino* in Rome. Following these triumphs she was invited to join the Vienna State Opera: Her Vienna debuts to date include *Pamina (Kinder Zauberflöte)*, *Cinderella (Cinderella / Alma Deutscher)*, *Gretel (Hänsel&Gretel / Humperdinck)*, *Musetta (La Bohème / Puccini)*, *Giannetta (L'Elisir d'amore / Donizetti)* and *Barbarina (Le Nozze di Figaro / Mozart)*.

Mariam Battistelli has performed with orchestras including *The Vienna Philharmonic*, *ORF Radio Symphony Orchestra*, *Orquestra de la Comunitat Valenciana*, *Orchestre Philharmonique de Monte-Carlo*, *Prague Philharmonic Orchestra* and *Philharmonisches Staatsorchester Hamburg*, and under conductors *Bychkov*, *Gergiev*, *Mehta*, *Thielemann*, *Kobel* and *Fischer*.

Highlights of season 2019/20 include a return to the Royal Opera House Muscat (singing *Musetta* in *La Bohème*) co-produced with the Opera De Monte-Carlo with performances in Vienna and Monte-Carlo, debut with Hamburg State Opera, and working with pianists and conductors including *Marco Armiliato*, *Roger Vignoles*, *Carlo Montanaro* and *Daniele Callegari*.
